TV LICENSING

After researching their legislation it was easy to find a massive kink in the TV Licensing armour. It would appear that TV Licensing ("TVL") have been misleading the Courts with regards to the warrant.

TVL applies to a Court under Section 366(1) of Communications Act 2003 ("the Act"), however, under Section 366(5) of the Act, a warrant has limited powers, and watching TV without a licence is not a power under a warrant.

Subsection (5) stipulates: "The powers conferred by a warrant under this section on a person authorised by OFCOM are exercisable in relation only to a contravention or suspected contravention of a condition of a TV licence relating to interference with wireless telegraphy."

Therefore, watching TV with or without a licence would not be deemed as interference with wireless telegraphy.

Under subsection 10 of the same Section, it stipulates: "In this section— "interference", in relation to wireless telegraphy, has the same meaning as in the Wireless Telegraphy Act 2006...".

"Interference" under Section 116(1) of Wireless Telegraphy Act 2006, stipulates "In this Act "wireless telegraphy" means the emitting or receiving, over paths that are not provided by any material substance constructed or arranged for the purpose, of energy to which subsection (2) applies.

(2) This subsection applies to electromagnetic energy of a frequency not exceeding 3,000 gigahertz that—

(a) serves for conveying messages, sound or visual images (whether or not the messages, sound or images are actually received by anyone), or for operating or controlling machinery or apparatus; or

(b) is used in connection with determining position, bearing or distance, or for gaining information as to the presence, absence, position or motion of an object or of a class of objects.".

In conclusion – there are no powers of entry by any OFCOM approved TVL employee, agent or representative. It's all fakery as per usual with their corrupt system and oddly, the above isn't a loophole, it's all in their own legislation...
