

## **BBC BIAS / A LONGSTANDING HABIT**

### **What Doctors Don't Tell You**

President Trump is discovering what we at WDDTY have known for years: the BBC is inherently biased, and edits, cuts and deletes to create a view of the world that fits its own sensibilities.

It doesn't like Trump, and it edited a film of his speech on Capitol Hill in 2021 that made it seem he was fomenting insurrection, and it broadcast it just weeks before the US Presidential election in 2024.

It doesn't like alternative medicine or any attack on conventional medicine, either. When WDDTY launched as a magazine on the news-stands, we felt the Beeb's full opprobrium. We were attacked on one BBC radio chat show, accused of promoting 'quack medicine'. The trouble was, we weren't invited to speak and put our side of the story, an editorial practice that goes against the BBC charter of presenting a balanced view.

Even when we were invited on shows, our views were heavily edited, and only a few comments we made ever made it into the broadcast, while the person propounding the orthodox view was given most of the time.

A few years earlier, the BBC removed every mention of alternative remedies from its website—and since then has made damned sure they never get mentioned in broadcasts.

This approach reached its nadir during the Covid pandemic, when the BBC gave up any pretence of being an independent news service and instead became the unquestioning mouthpiece of a government exerting powers akin to a totalitarian state.
